Todd Nicolet called for a vote on how to proceed with contractor selection based on bids received July 8, 2020.

Dianne Ford moved to proceed with negotiations based on the lowest base bid plus the alternate option of luxury vinyl tile (LVT) flooring. Matt Buckmaster seconded. Motion passed.

Jackie Tomlin provided an update on permits.

Alamance County has issued us our foundation permit. Because we have selected a pre-engineered metal building, we cannot get final permits until the building drawings have been submitted. Jackie anticipates receiving those drawings soon. We have submitted stormwater permits, which could take 30-60 days to be approved; however, because we received misinformation about these permits, Jackie anticipates an expedited approval process. Jackie reported that two permits came in today from the NC Department of Transportation, and we will be looking out for the driveway permit soon. Jackie and the team at Little have been working closely with Keith Downing, Landscape Architect with CLH Design, regarding permitting. In short, we've made a lot of progress, but not all permits are in yet. We will check back in on permits at our next board meeting in two weeks.
